

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7**

**OFFERED BY MR. BISHOP OF NEW YORK**

In section 5003(e) of the bill, in the matter proposed to be added as subsection (p)(4)(A)(i) of section 402 of title 23, United States Code, strike “15 years and 6 months” and insert “16 years”.

In section 5003(e) of the bill, in the matter proposed to be added as subsection (p)(4)(A) of section 402 of title 23, United States Code, strike clauses (iv) and (v) and insert the following:

1                   “(iv) requires an individual with a  
2                   learner’s permit to be accompanied and su-  
3                   pervised by a licensed driver who is 21  
4                   years of age or older at all times when op-  
5                   erating a motor vehicle;

6                   “(v) prohibits an individual with a  
7                   learner’s permit from using a cellular tele-  
8                   phone or any other communications device  
9                   while driving, except in the case of an  
10                  emergency; and

11                  “(vi) is in effect until the commence-  
12                  ment of the intermediate stage or until the

1 date on which the applicable individual at-  
2 tains 18 years of age.

In section 5003(e) of the bill, in the matter proposed to be added as subsection (p)(4)(B)(ii) of section 402 of title 23, United States Code, strike “6 months” and insert “1 year”.

In section 5003(e) of the bill, in the matter proposed to be added as subsection (p)(4)(B) of section 402 of title 23, United States Code, strike clauses (iii) and (iv) and insert the following:

3 “(iii) prohibits the operation of a  
4 motor vehicle by an individual to whom the  
5 stage applies, if that individual is trans-  
6 porting more than one nonfamilial pas-  
7 senger under the age of 21 years and there  
8 is no licensed driver 21 years of age or  
9 older present in the motor vehicle;

10 “(iv) prohibits an individual to whom  
11 the stage applies from using a cellular tele-  
12 phone or any other communications device  
13 while driving, except in the case of an  
14 emergency; and

15 “(v) prohibits an individual to whom  
16 the stage applies from operating a motor

1 vehicle between the hours of 10 p.m. and  
2 4 a.m., unless such individual is accom-  
3 panied and supervised by a licensed driver  
4 who is 21 years of age or older.
